- Existing reports modifications can be prototyped without recompiling.
- Spacing Charts provide an excellent method for creating hardcopy documentation of a system's report and screen layouts.
- The options are easily run within PDM thru these user-defined options, which are shipped in the option file HAWKEYE/USERPDM.

  - "CP" PRTCBLPRT SRCFILE(&L/&F) SRCMBR(&N)
  - "DP" PRTDDSPRT SRCFILE(&L/&F) SRCMBR(&N)
  - "DD" PRTRPGDSP SRCFILE(&L/&F) SRCMBR(&N)
- Each report includes a "field summary" showing what fields print and what positions they cover.
